The topics of the field study were focused on crucial themes of human geography titled - STATUS OF FARMING PRACTICES, SOCIO–ECONOMIC SITUATION AND TOURISM IN HIMACHAL PRADESH (CASE STUDY OF CHAIL AND KUFRI). The questionnaire based survey covered topics of study on 'Practices and Prospects of Organic farming in Rural Hilly Terrains', Sustainable Tourism: case of Nature and Adventure Tourism", and "Livelihood Structure of the Rural Inhabitants in Hilly Region"



The Study was conducted in two phases covering residential/commercial and institutional areas with the objectives of identifying disaster prone areas due to land use changes, the compliance of construction codes and the community resilience factors. 





EVACUATION PLAN FOR KNC-GEOGRAPHY DEPARTMENT

The Department of Geography created an Evacuation Plan for the institute. The aim was to assess the vulnerability and propose measures for capacity building and preparedness of both the physical structure and the stakeholders. Floor-wise and section-wise plans of building indicating the location, size and capacity of different rooms, exit points, and structural deficiencies were prepared. Students were assigned the task involving taking measurements and creating the maps which are displayed in College. Maps depict evacuation routes from different floors to be followed in case of emergency.

THE ENTREPRENEURSHIP CELL

Asar- The Entrepreneurship Cell' seeks to develop sustainable models, inculcate entrepreneurial skills, help improve quality of living and empowering the underprivileged section of the society. It started '**Project Kadam'**, in 2017to empower cobbler communities across Delhi-NCR by creating brand new slippers through donated denim.

There were six phases of the Project-Primary Research; Product Development; Building a Network - Random Selection; Product Manufacturing; Market Channel; Feedback Loop

The Project created widespread impact.

Waste management/ Environmental Impact: It managed to redirect 60kgs of denim from landfills helping in waste management as denim is a coagulant and contains a toxic blend of chemicals.

Economic Impact: It provided a sustainable source of income to the cobblers.

Social Impact: It has created better living conditions for the cobblers as well as their children.


THE RESERACH, INNOVATION AND SUSTAINABLE EDUCATION CELL
