### Pamper the Paws- An Online Campaign to promote Peace and Compassion—January 2021-8<sup>th</sup> February 2021

As the name suggests, the aim of the campaign was to provide shelter, feed and rescue stray animals. This campaign was founded on the principles of peaceful co-existence and promotion of moral value. It was initiated in January 2021 and concluded on 8<sup>th</sup> of February 2021. Around 20 youth from all over India participated in this campaign along with the members of Shining Network. They sent their entries through e-mail and social media accounts. Their entries included videos and photos of them pampering the strays in every possible way—feeding, arranging shelter, providing warm clothing, looking out for adoption, etc. To raise awareness about strays, the social media team of the society posted valuable information such as diet charts for stray animals, common diseases found in stray animals, do's and don'ts related to stray dogs and cats, etc. It aimed to accommodate and provide needful help to animals, who are often subject to neglect and violence.
