ANNUAL REPORT OF KAMALA NEHRU COLLEGE NORTHEAST CELL: JULY 2019- JUNE 2020

An 'Orientation-cum-Get-together' meeting was scheduled by the Northeast Cell members on 23rd August 2019 in Room No: L11. The Nodal Officer and the faculty members initiated a discussion with the students on inculcating a holistic development/growth through an array of enriching experiences during their student years in college. The discussion also extended on issues such as the importance of attendance, submission of Internal Assessment on time, consistent habit of getting constructive feedback on their written and oral performances from their respective teachers, participation in corporate college life activities, involvement in various societies as per their talents/interests, maintaining a healthy student-teacher relationship, and promotion of varied Northeast culture and tradition. 36 students had attended the orientation.

Some of the concerns, issues and suggestions expressed by the students were as follow:

- 1. The students felt the need to sensitize the non-Northeast students about their various regions, their distinct identities and the diversities of their food culture, festivals, history,etc. The concern was raised as it was felt many mainland students are not aware about the Northeast region.
- 2. It was collectively experienced that compared to the previous years, the students from other regions are more accommodative and helpful to the present Northeast students than experienced by their seniors in the past years. The students' recognised that the adaptability to new culture, environment and language play an important factor in helping the students to blend or fit-in with their peers in such cosmopolitan centers like Delhi.
- The students felt that the College Placement Cell should broaden their platform by including social sciences since many Northeast students belong to the social sciences streams.
