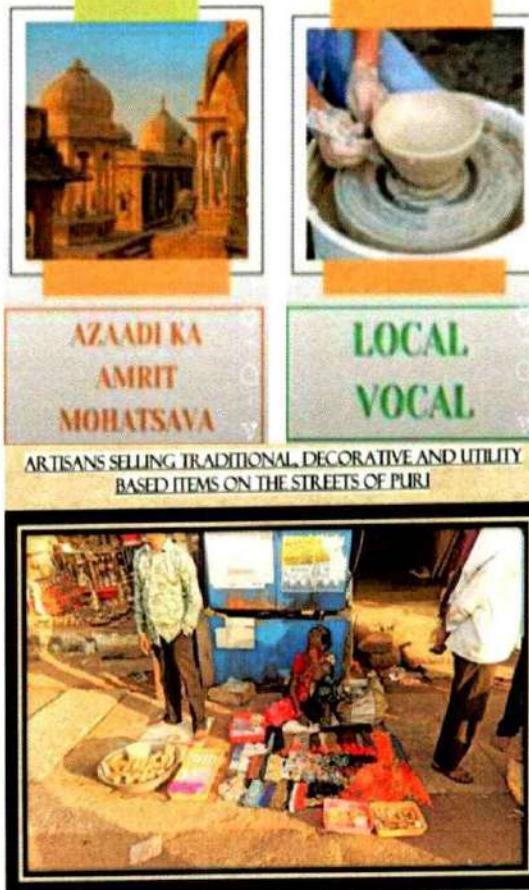

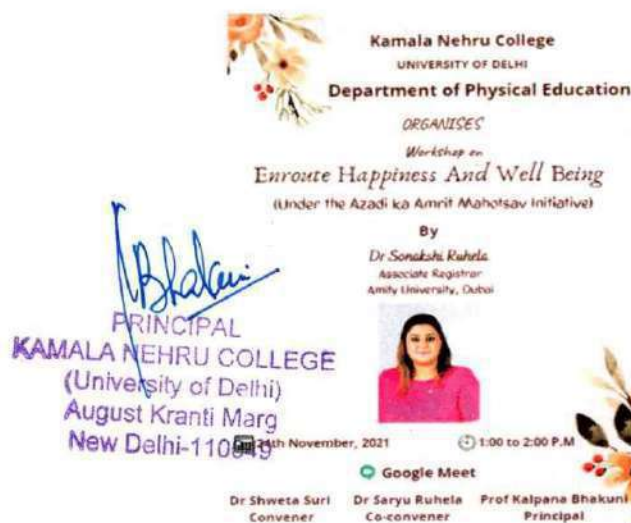

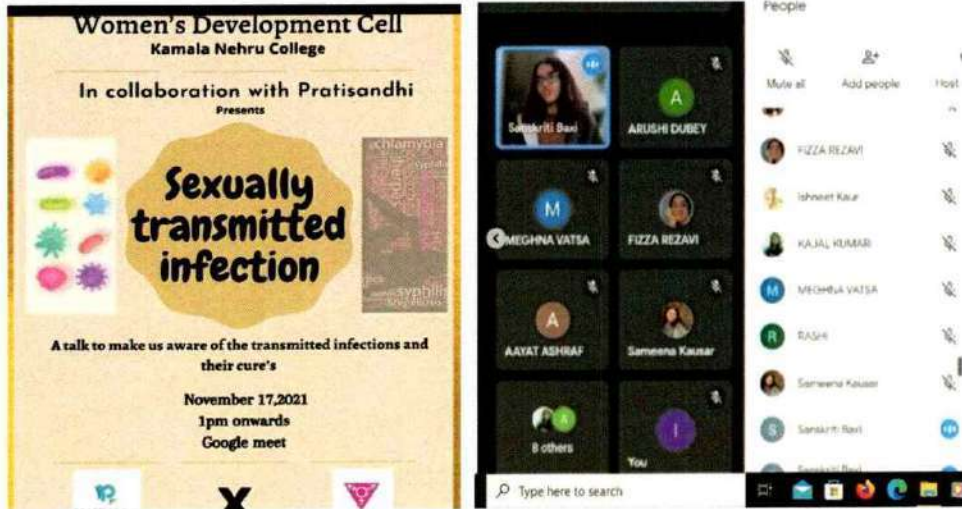
4. Name of activity- A talk on methods of contraception

The project works with a community of disabled people to make scented candles that are sold in ceramic pots therefore supporting the local potter community as well. The project started with a target research for a community in need of subsistence due to the pandemic and the lack of customers. Dilaab works with the Potter community families that have migrated to the market called the banjara market in Gurugram with a vast range of ceramic products. These ceramics (50 gm and 100 gm capacity cups) were chosen, bought and transported by the team along with rest of the raw material (scents, beeswax etc.) required to make the candles, over the month of January through online platforms. By the end of January and February, the candles were out for sale on our social media handles. The purchasing, payments and shipping were all done online. The content and graphics team actively worked on creating social media marketing campaigns for expanding our reach and improvising on product aesthetics.

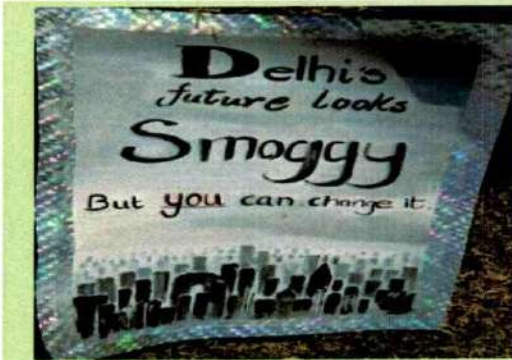
